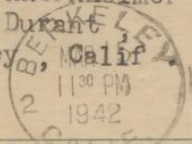

If you can , publish it under my name and keep the money until we shall meet again . The story was not yet published here and is quite new . _ I was deeply concerned about the names of our dead and lamented friends you were lining up in your letter . Now also St. Zweig has "joined the majority" and under circumstances which make his decease still more depressing . He was your friend as he was mine . But we are not permitted to despair . We must fight we must win and Austrias independence must be restored . For that we must live: we the representatives of those who died .
