mit Lichtbildern, and managed to get the
matter very favourably mentioned by the
Minister of Health in the House of Commons
last year. Mr. Chamberlain said that
he would view very favourably any scheme
similar to the Austrian carried out in
England. The coal strike delayed matters,
but in two or three districts they are
now forming Associations.

I do hope you are keeping fairly well

Year Day of 1925 at their house and
how you were like a sweet Mother to
us all.

I hope that a great friend of mine,

give her an introduction to you if you
will allow me to do so.

I am very busy with international
work now for the League of Nations Union,
but in the evenings sometimes give the
Liedlings lecture to French people who
are enthusiastic when they see that the
Austrians have accomplished.
