you will readily obtain. -

Arrange for 4 Impressions
of each view, uncoloured

And for 2 Impressions, Coloured
by one of your careful artists
And further arrange the views
to be taken and for a large scale.

Altogether I beg, for about
the cost of colouring each
impression. also, the number
of views which in your
opinion it is desirable to take.
