Vienna November 20th 1848

My dear Sir!

I am sorry to trouble you with these lines - but in consequence of the unsettled state of affairs, the families of my connexion and those who are indebted to me, have during my absence at Ems, left Vienna which has for the moment placed me in a difficult position - I expect letters daily from London with money, but as I must arrange some accounts here, I trust you will not take it amiss if I request the loan of 100 florins, until I can receive the necessary funds from England when it will be my first care to repay you with my most sincere thanks - My wife will give you a receipt, which I by this letter confirm -
